France-Le Grand Mazarin, Paris

Known for its collection of eclectic boutique hotels, housed in private and unique residences in various parts of France, the Maisons Pariente group debuts its first urban property, Le Grand Mazarin, in the heart of the Ville Lumiere. Located a stone's throw from the Seine, in the Marais, the hotel is housed in a historic building, which has been totally reinvented by the architect Martin Brudnizki, who has created an environment in keeping with the artistic heritage of the surroundings, enriched from elements of luxury and comfort for discerning travellers. The extravagant 17th century inspired decoris juxtaposed with lush textures and intricate patterns, while floor-to-ceiling windows fill the spaces with natural light. Only fifty rooms and eleven suites, a choice that gives an intimate and welcoming environment. The restaurant, the fashionable bar and a splendid swimming pool complete the work.
