Right beside the Rond Point des Pistes you'll find Hôtel Le Coucou, which puts a playful spin on the timber-clad chalet. Scallop-edged headboards rest against walls painted terracotta (1) and the fairytale snowscapes seen from the balconies can leave you speechless. The crowd is decidedly style-forward and with miles of pristine cruising territory on the doorstep, it's a ravishing winter escape.

Nothing stokes the appetite like a morning of powder-shredding and Méribel's foodie scene packs a real punch. Le Cèpe's out-there menu puts the spotlight on the humble mushroom while Chalet Tonia, at the bottom of Roc de Tougne, serves Savoyard classics. Best of all is Le Coucou's Beefbar - score a table on the terrace and settle in for a leisurely lunch. Don't miss the black Angus filet mignon with truffle mash and wash it down with a tipple from the inventive list of cocktails.

INDULGE

Softly lit with stunning views across the slopes, Le Coucou's spa is the ideal antidote to an adrenalinefuelled morning on the slopes, featuring cosy nooks for lounging, two pools (3) and an irresistible bill of therapies using Tata Harper and Aime. The Alpine, combining vigorous kneading with full-body stretching, has been designed to speed up muscle recovery, leaving tired limbs feeling light as air.

EXPLORE

In the heart of Les Trois Vallées in the French Alps, Méribel couldn't be more picturesque, and it's blessed with a winning sunshineto-snow ratio, too. From the gentle tree-lined trails above the village to downhills that offer supremely good powder without having to go offpiste, there's heaps of terrain to get stuck into (2). Particularly exhilarating is Les Bosses – all monster moguls and shelf-like drops. It's not for the faint-hearted, but the pay-off is huge for seasoned snow junkies.
